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

"We had a wonderful Christmas program Saturday evening, at which several of the students performed musical and other numbers, and the gifts and attention were, as always, huge hits.



"On the next day we took the students and several family members to *Santa Marta*, one of the most popular restaurants in Oaxaca, for a holiday dinner. Again, the students were delighted and most appreciative of this event on their behalf.

"On Monday we traveled with the students to a local nursing home which the students visit on a routine basis, where we served a meal to the residents. In addition to performing several musical numbers, the students interacted extensively with the residents, helping them to and from their rooms, serving their meals, and in some cases feeding them. It was clear from attending this event that our goal of instilling servant hearts in the AIMS students is a huge success. The love and tenderness shown by the students towards the nursing home residents was very moving.



"On the day after our departure, the students took a trip to Huatulco, the site of our September mission trip. Huatulco is on the southern Pacific coast of Mexico, and this trip allowed several of our students to see the ocean for the first time. Donor contributions both provided funds for transportation, lodging and meal expenses, and also gave each of the students a modest amount of spending money for personal use and gifts".

Due to the support of several people and the Scholars saving and making money through several projects, our Scholars spent some days at the beach with Pilar. They snorkeled, fished, learned how to swim and prayed together. They were able to see more of the beauty of creation.





A Few Words in Loving Memory of Dr. Robert Paul Dalton Jr.
